Joe Greer was an officer, trainer, administrator, student, writer, teacher and an airplane pilot. Joe Greer was born in Perris, CA on February 29, 1916. Mr. Greer's family moved to Corona a year later and he never moved away. He graduated from Corona High School in 1934. Following his graduation he worked at local service stations then turned into selling automobiles. In 1940, Mr. Greer married Winifred (Judy) Sutter of Corona and had one daughter Mary Ann. He had a step-daughter Dr. Carene Davis-Stitt of Eugene, Oregon and one step-grandson David Cakmar-Stitt of Tucson, Arizona.

In 1941 at the age of 25 he joined the Corona Police Department. He worked as the police chief from 1966 to 1976 after starting out as a patrolman. Mr. Greer worked for the Corona Police Department for 35 years and worked for the city until 1989.

Even with all his accomplishments with the Corona Police Department, Mr. Greer was most proud to have served with General George S. Patton's 3rd Army in World War II. He was a military police officer and part of a group that helped Patton's army wheel about and attack the German army during the Battle of the Bulge in December 1944.

Mr. Greer was also a teacher. In 1950, adult education decided to offer a peace officers' science program and Mr. Greer was selected to teach. In 1955 he began teaching Criminal Law through the State Department of education. He also taught classes at Chaffey College, Riverside City College, Sheriff's Academy and special classes for the Department of Professional and Vocational Standards, division of investigation, at both Riverside and Pasadena. He also wrote a 275 page text and a 60 page manual for the State Departments Fish and Game department.

After his retirement from the police force, Mr. Greer continued to serve the city as general manager of the Corona Municipal Airport, a job he took on in 1972, while still police chief. Mr. Greer was a pilot since the age of 18. In the early 1950's Mr. Greer and several other pilots established the city's first public airport near what is now the Highway 91-Interstate 15 Interchange. Mr. Greer and the other pilots continued to push the city for an airport and in 1960 Corona began leasing a 96 acre site that is now the Corona Municipal Airport off Butterfield Drive.

Mr. Greer died at the age of 83 at Loma Linda University Medical Center of brain cancer.

This collection consists of two series. Series one includes records and correspondence related to the Corona Police Department. Series two consists of records, photographs, and correspondence from the Corona Airport.
