The *Friends of the Corona Public Library* are an independent, non-profit organization that supports the Library and preservation of community history. Formed in the fall of 1964, the *Friends* (as they are commonly known) had originally planned on expanding Children's Services by adding books and providing story hours. Since that time, the *Friends* have donated toward the purchase of not only children's books, but items for the entire collection. In addition to books, the Friends have purchased various furnishings, equipment and decorations for the Library. The *Friends* activities and projects include: *The Friends Book & Gift Shop*, the *Adopt-a-Book* Program, the Summer Reading Program, author talks and other special programs, major gifts to the Library, and the distribution of their newsletter, "*News & Notes*." Their contribution can also be seen in winter time, when holiday festivities such as decorations and holiday musical entertainment brighten up the Library.

When the Library Board of Trustees set aside in the new library, space for a local history room which was eventually named the W.D. Addison Heritage Room in 1987, a Heritage Committee was formed in 1975. Starting in 1977, the Friends became supporters of the Heritage Committee. The by-laws of the Friends of the Library were revised and this committee was recognized as a regular standing committee. As funds were collected, they were deposited in a Friend's special account. The Heritage Committee and the Friends combined their twin goals of preservation and public service to provide Corona with an archive of documents, photos, artifacts and information relating to the City's history, as well as an ample collection of California history books. In addition to providing local and state history resources, in 1999, the Heritage Room became a Passport Acceptance Facility, adding yet another dimension of public service to the Library. The Heritage Committee last met in September, 2002.

This collection consists of 15 series. <u>Series 1</u> is Articles of Incorporation and By-Laws. <u>Series 2</u> is History. <u>Series 3</u> is Annual Reports. <u>Series 4</u> is Awards and Recognition. <u>Series 5</u> is Correspondence. <u>Series 6</u> is Donations/Gifts to the Library. <u>Series 7</u> is Financial Reports*. <u>Series 8</u> is Membership. <u>Series 9</u> is Minutes*. <u>Series 10</u> is Newsletters. <u>Series 11</u> is Policies and Procedures. <u>Series 12</u> is Programs. <u>Series 13</u> is Publicity. Series 14 is Volunteers. Series 15 is Heritage Committee.

* Due to the irregularity of donated documents, some treasurers reports are filed with the Minutes, and some are in the Financial Records. Treasurer's reports are also included in the month for which they are the records. Since some came in alone and some with the minutes, the financial records are usually filed according to the month listed on the records.
