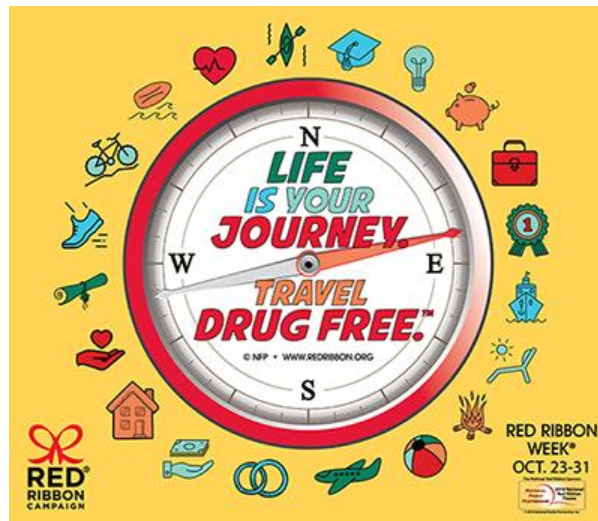

Contest Rules and Procedures

★★Poster Contest★★

MUST USE THEME: *“Life is Your Journey, Travel Drug Free.”*

FORMAT FOR ALL POSTERS:

- On the backside of the poster, **CLEARLY PRINT:** Student's First and Last Name, Address, City, Zip, Phone Number, Name of School, Teacher, Track and Grade Level.
- Use only **11” high X 17” wide**, white construction paper
- Must be in **Landscape** format
- Can use any art medium (crayon, paint, pen, pencil, etc...)
- **NO** Use of 3D materials such as ribbons, crystals and other glue-on decorations. These posters will be ineligible for the Carol Addis Contest.
- Poster art **must be a free hand drawing/painting** only. *NO USE OF COPYRIGHTED CARTOON CHARACTERS (example Mickey Mouse, Spiderman)*
- **“Life is Your Journey, Travel Drug Free.”** **MUST** appear on the front of the poster.
- Poster judged on creativity, originality, neatness and how well they convey the message and contest theme.

MUST USE THEME: *“Life is Your Journey, Travel Drug Free.”*

FORMAT FOR ALL CREATIVE WRITING ENTRIES:

- On a cover sheet **CLEARLY PRINT:** Students First and Last Name, Address, City, Zip, Phone Number, Name of School, Teacher, Track and Grade Level
- All entries should be a minimum of 50 words and no more than 500 words.
- Entries judged on creativity, neatness, originality and relevance to the theme.
