Project Title: Santa Ana River Trail Staging Area Sewer Extension, Project No. 2017-

31

Location: APN 102-020-005

Description: Due to the Phase II construction of the Auxiliary Embankment by the

Army Corp of Engineers, the City relocated existing City owned cathodic

protection equipment, and concrete encased existing reclaimed

waterline and sewer pipeline located within the Prado Dam area owned

by Orange County Flood Control District. At Riverside County Regional

Park and Open-Space District's (District) request, the City also extended

an existing public sewer manhole and installed a private sewer

forcemain as part of the project. These additional improvements will

serve a future District facility that will be located along the Santa Ana

River Trail.

Schedule: Construction started in July 2018 and completed in August 2018.

Project Cost: \$276,891.97


Funding: Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District funded 59% of
