



Vial of Life Fact Sheet

- ✓ The Vial of Life program is managed by the Corona Fire Department and the Corona Fire Safety Foundation, an IRS 501c3 non-profit.
- ✓ The Vial of Life kit is available free of charge due the partnership and financial support of Corona Regional Medical Center and Kaiser Permanente.
- ✓ The purpose of the Vial is to help Firefighters/Paramedics and Police Officers locate important personal information, in the event of an emergency.
- ✓ The Vial of Life should be a part of the disaster preparedness effort in every household. It is especially beneficial for residents with a medical history or who is prescribed medication.
- ✓ The Vial of Life kit contains:
 - INSTRUCTIONS - Explaining the program and how to participate.
 - PERSONAL INFORMATION SHEET - To be completed and placed inside the Vial.
 - VIAL – To be placed inside the refrigerator door.
 - MAGNET - Placed on the front of the refrigerator in the upper right hand corner
- ✓ To help residents keep their medication list updated, he/she can ask their pharmacist to print a list of their medications or use a computer to generate a list and then place the list inside their Vial.
- ✓ One actual Vial per household can contain a Personal Information Sheet for each resident.
- ✓ Copies of the Personal Information Sheet can be placed in other locations such as a wallet, car glovebox or disaster/evacuation kit.
- ✓ Residents can obtain free Vial of Life kits from any Corona Fire Station, City Hall, Corona Regional Medical Center, Kaiser Permanente and local participating medical offices and pharmacies.
