PP2019-0002: A proposal to demolish an existing 12,690 square foot restaurant previously occupied by Claim Jumper and rebuild a new 9,570 square foot Lazy Dog restaurant with a 1,843 square foot outdoor dining patio located at 380 N. McKinley Street (Corona Hills Plaza) within the Sub-Regional Shopping Center designation of the Northeast Corona Specific Plan (SP81-2).
