<u>City Council consideration of an appeal of the Planning and Housing Commission's denial of CUP2018-0003</u>, a conditional use permit application to establish a 76-foot high wireless telecommunications facility designed as a mono-eucalyptus tree on a 0.69-acre property located south of Chase Drive and west of Skyline Drive in the R-1A (Single Family Residential) zone (Applicant: Peter Blied of Plancom, Inc. for Renegade Towers).

The public is invited to attend the City Council meeting and comment on the applications described above. Due to time constraints and the number of persons wishing to give oral testimony, each speaker will be limited to three minutes. You may wish to make your comments in writing and submit them to the City Clerk for inclusion into the public record. If you challenge any portion of these projects in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered at, or prior to the public hearing.
