CORONA FIRE DEPARTMENT SEEKS PUBLIC ASSISTANCE IN FIRE INVESTIGATIONS

CORONA, CA— The Corona Fire Department is asking for the public's help in finding the person or persons responsible for two separate fires that occurred last week at the Penrose Apartment Community, located at the corner of River Rd. and N. Cota St. in Corona. Based on evidence obtained by fire investigators, both fires are believed to have been deliberately set.

The first fire occurred at approximately 11:46 p.m. on October 23, 2019 and caused extensive damage to four vehicles and a carport. The second fire occurred at approximately 1 a.m. on October 25, 2019 and destroyed one vehicle. The Corona Fire Department quickly extinguished both blazes. No firefighters or civilians were injured.
