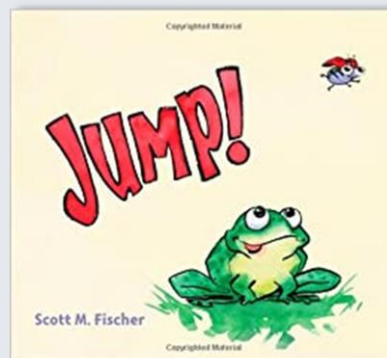
Early Literacy

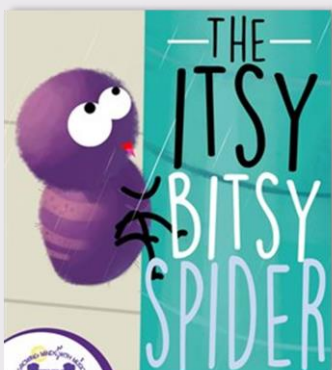
