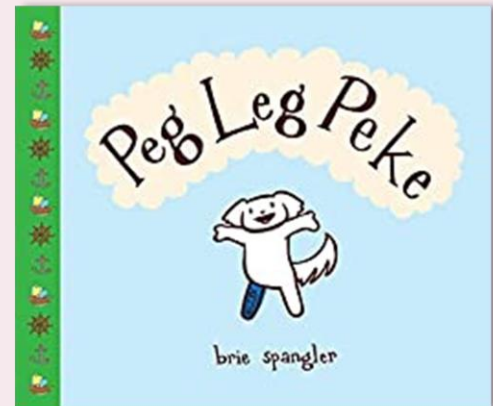
Early Literacy

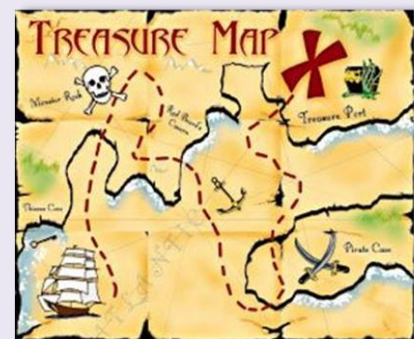
