

- Enjoy storytime at home and practice early literacy skills by completing these fun activities!






Create a Paper Pirate Hat

Step1: Fold a piece of paper or newspaper like a hamburger.

Step 2: Fold like a hamburger again.

Step 3: Fold the top right side and top left side to bottom middle so it creates a point at the top.

Step 4: Open the bottom, and fold bottom up on back and front. Secure with tape, glue, or elastic.
