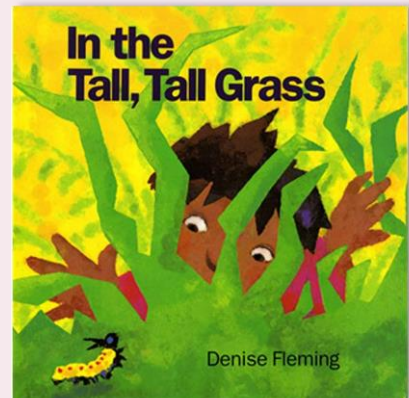
Early Literacy

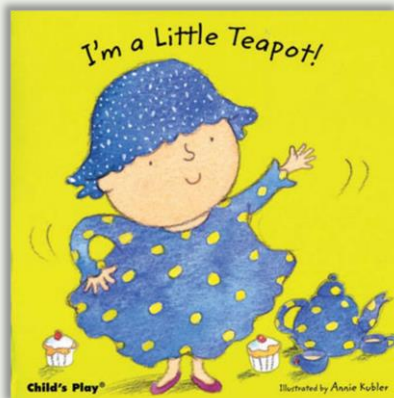
