- Enjoy storytime at home and practice early literacy skills by completing these fun activities!



#### **CRAFT**

#### Clothespins Giraffe

**Step1:** Cut one large circle(body), one medium circle(face), one small circle(tail), and two tiny circles(antlers)

**Step 2:** Cut one long skinny rectangle (neck) and one short skinny rectangle (tail)

Step 3: Glue the neck, tail, and face to the body

Step 4: Glue the antlers to the face

Step 5: Clip on two clothespins (legs)

Step 6: Add eyes, mouth, and spots



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
