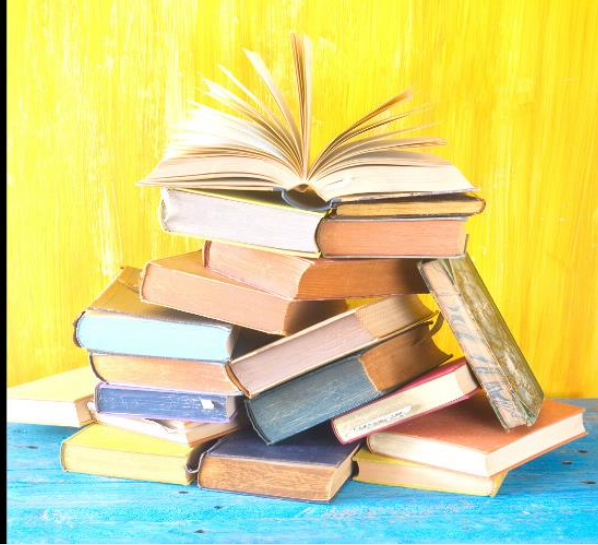

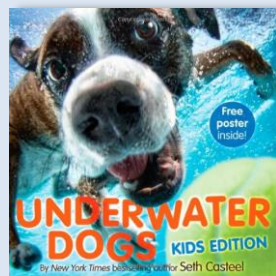
- The City of Corona Adaptive program is proud to offer a variety of recreational, educational, social, and creative activities for those 16 years and older with developmental disabilities.

### I SPY: Home Edition

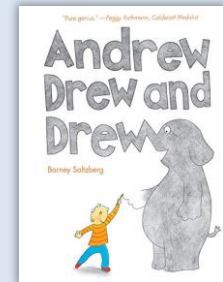
- Step 1:** Read one instruction card.

# I SPY: HOME EDITION ACTIVITY

**Skill(s):** The skill being focused on today is following instructions. Following instructions is essential when participants are entering the workforce. They will be asked to complete a series of tasks and will be expected to complete them.

**Need:**

- Instruction cards (provided)
- Examples of each instruction  
ex. I spy with my little eye something soft—teddy bear, I spy something white—pillow, I spy something that belongs in the kitchen—spoon, etc.
- Timer

**Instructions:**

1. Read the first instruction card and prompt participants to find something in their room/home that matches the card.
  - a. Ex. I spy something red—red cup
2. Participants will have one minute to follow the instructions on the card.
3. Once they have found their item, participants will be asked to share what it is and where they found it.
4. Each participant who completes the instructions in the given time will receive a point.
5. Repeat with next card.
