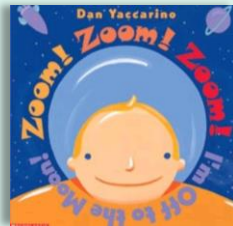


Early Literacy

Toilet Paper Roll Rocket

- Step1:** Gather a toilet/paper towel roll, markers, paper, glue/tape, decorations
- Step2:** Decorate the body of the rocket
- Step3:** Cut out a 2" circle and wrap it around to make a cone, secure with tape for your top
- Step4:** Cut out two triangles for your base
- Step5:** Cut two slits at the bottom of your rocket, and insert your triangles to create the base
- Step6:** Blast off!
