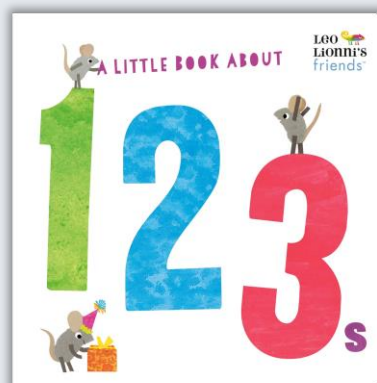
## Early Literacy
