NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Notice of Intent to Adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration for the WRF-3 Lift Station Project

In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the State CEQA guidelines, the City of Corona has prepared an Initial Study to evaluate the environmental effects associated with the proposed WRF-3 Lift Station Project construction at the City owned Water Reclamation Facility #3 (WRF-3) in the City of Corona, Riverside County. WRF-3 is located approximately 850 feet southeast of the intersection of Cajalco Road and Temescal Canyon Road. The sewer lift station will be constructed within the existing asphalt parking lot at WRF-3. Construction of the proposed lift station is anticipated to occur over a 9-month period starting in late 2020.

The 30-day public comment period for the Draft Mitigated Negative Declaration begins on June 22, 2020 and closes on July 22, 2020. The document is available for review at the City of Corona Clerks Office located at 400 S. Vicentia Avenue, Corona CA 92882. Comments may be made in writing at any time during the comment period, but must be received by 5:00 p.m. on July 22, 2020.

The public is invited to attend the City Council meeting and comment on the application described above. Due to time constraints and the number of persons wishing to give oral testimony, each speaker will be limited to three minutes. You may wish to make your comments in writing and submit them to the City Clerk for inclusion into the public record. If you challenge any portion of these projects in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered at, or prior to the public hearing.
