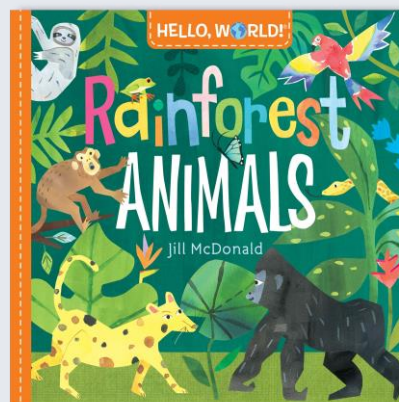
Early Literacy
