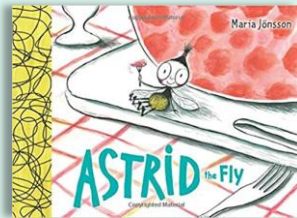


Early Literacy

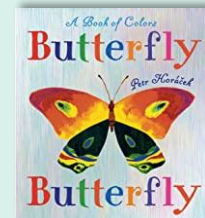

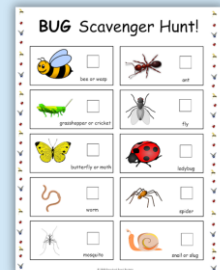
