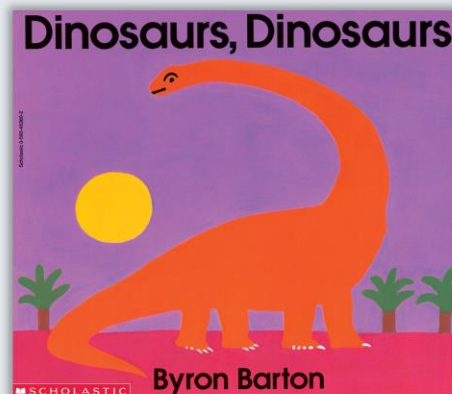
Early Literacy

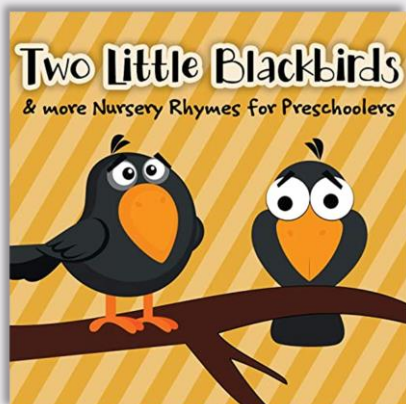
