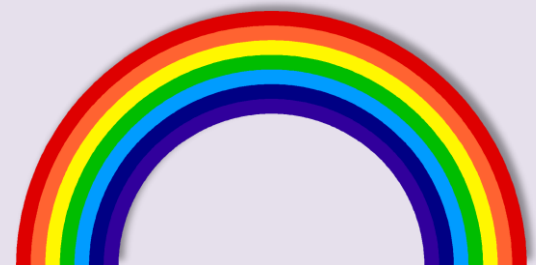
Scented Rainbow

Step 1: Pick a color of the rainbow to show to the group.

Step 2: The group has 30 seconds to come up with as many items as they can that they think smell like the color.

Step 3: For each correct answer, the group gets a point. Repeat with the next color.



SCENTED RAINBOW ACTIVITY

Skill(s): Skills being worked on our communication skills. Participants will have to work with a team and effectively communicate their answer to the host of the game.

Need:

- Color Sheet (every color of the rainbow)
 - Construction paper would work easiest but printing a square of each color of the rainbow and printing it out would work too.
- Items that are of the colors given that have scents to them (ex. Red for strawberry)
 - These are to be used as an example and it is okay if a participant uses the example as an answer.

Instructions:

1. Create teams of 2-3 people each (depending on how many participants you have divide that equally to create teams.
 - a. If you are hosting this activity on Zoom or another video conference service be sure you can see all your clients on the screen.
2. Using the color sheets present one to the group. Each group member should be either listing their scents on a sheet of paper or trying to come up with a few in their head. They have 30 seconds to complete their lists.
 - a. They are not to give their responses yet. They will each get a turn to give their answers once they are called on.
3. Call on each member of the group to list their answers. Each scent named and correct will earn that team a point. The team with the most points will win.
4. Repeat this with each color of the rainbow giving other teams the opportunity to win a round.
