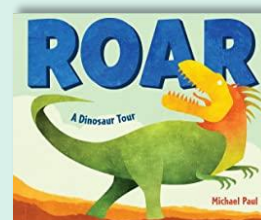
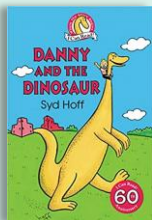
Early Literacy

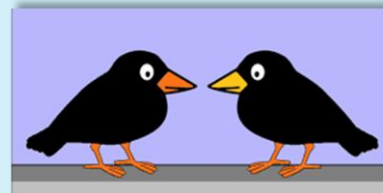
