

DIY Puffy Paint Spiderweb

Supplies: Flour, baking powder, food coloring, water, sealable baggies, paper, crayons

DIY Puffy Paint Spiderweb

Step 1:	Add one cup of flour, 3 teaspoons of baking powder, 1 teaspoon of salt to a bowl	
Step 2:	Add water and stir until it is the consistency of pancake batter	
Step 3:	Divide the mixture into bags for different colors and add food coloring	
Step 4:	Seal the bags and squish in the color!	
Step 5:	Cut the corner open of the baggie to begin drawing your spiderweb design onto paper	
Step 6:	Pop your design into the microwave for 20-30 seconds to watch your paint grow!	
Step 7:	Add the Spider to its web!
