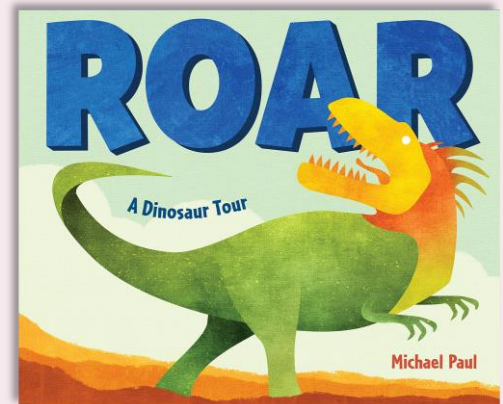
Early Literacy
