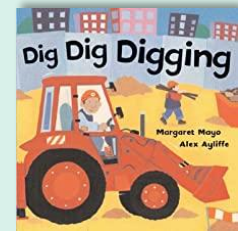
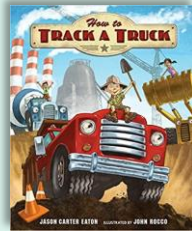
Early Literacy
