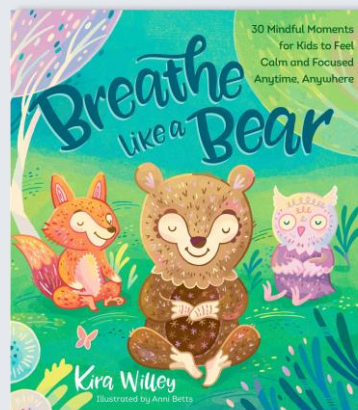
## Early Literacy

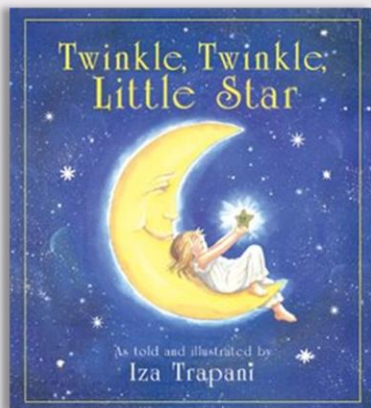
