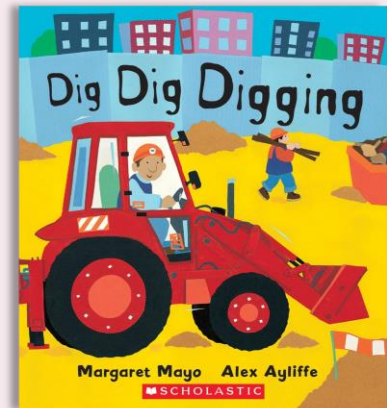
Early Literacy

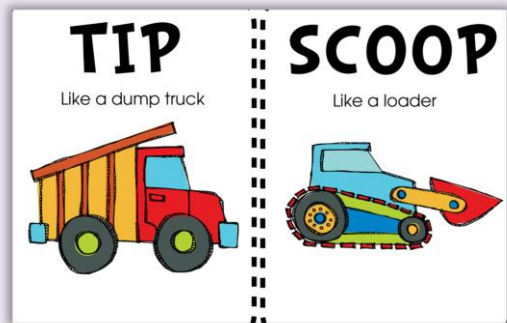
