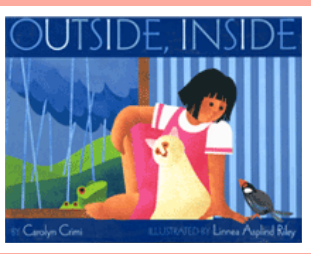

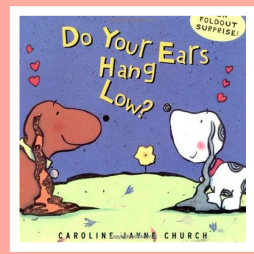
- The City of Corona Adaptive program is proud to offer a variety of recreational, educational, social, and creative activities for those 16 years and older with developmental disabilities.
