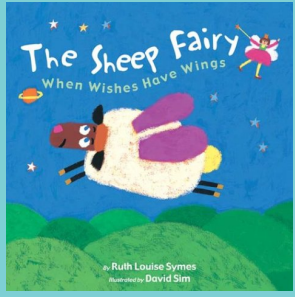
TODDLER TAKE-HOME STORYTIME

- Enjoy storytime at home and practice early literacy skills by completing these fun activities!

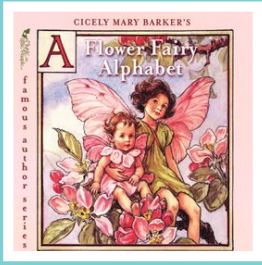
