Project Title: Sixth Street and Yorba Street Waterline Replacement and Pavement

Rehabilitation - Project No. 2018-05

Location: Within West Sixth Street between Yorba Street and South Smith Avenue

and within Yorba Street between West Sixth Street and Pleasant View

Avenue.

Description: Installation of 1,200 linear feet of 12-inch ductile iron pipe waterline to

replace aging and undersized steel pipe with a frequent leakage and

repair record. The new waterline provides reliability and enhanced fire

flow capability to the potable water distribution system. The project included paving 34,560 square feet of failed and failing pavement and

correcting drainage issues in Yorba Street.


Schedule: Construction started January 2020 and completed August 2020.





