

PUBLIC NOTICE

This is a public notice that the City of Corona's Planning and Housing Commission will conduct a public hearing in the City Council Chambers at 400 S. Vicentia Ave., Monday, October 12, 2020, at 6:00 p.m. or thereafter upon the following:

ZTA2020-0003 - Zone text amendment to Title 17 of the Corona Municipal Code, amending multiple sections for the purpose of regulating commercial cannabis businesses and revising cannabis related definitions and terminology.

A negative declaration for the project has been prepared pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines § 15070, and made available for public comment between September 16, 2020 and October 5, 2020. The negative declaration shall be considered for adoption by the City Council on October 7, 2020 concurrent with proposed amendments to Corona Municipal Code (CMC) Title 5.36 and Title 9.19. Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines § 15162, no further environmental consideration is required by the Planning Commission as the proposed amendments to Title 17 implement Titles 5.36 and 9.19, and do not constitute a substantial changes to the project or environmental circumstances, or introduce new information.
