**PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the City of Corona, California, will publish the draft 2019-2020 Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER) for a 15-day public review and comment period. The CAPER is an annual progress report to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development reflecting the accomplishments of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) programs for funds expended during fiscal year 2019-2020 in relationship to the goals and objectives stated in the 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan and the 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan.

A copy of the draft CAPER will be available for public review during business hours starting Monday, December 7, 2020 and ending Monday, December 21, 2020 at the City's Community Development Department and the City Clerk's Office located at 400 S. Vicentia Avenue, Corona. The draft CAPER may also be reviewed at the Corona Public Library, Reference Desk, located at 650 S. Main Street, Corona, or online at <a href="https://www.CoronaCA.gov/cdbg">www.CoronaCA.gov/cdbg</a>. The public review and comment period will conclude at 5:00 p.m. on December 21, 2020.
