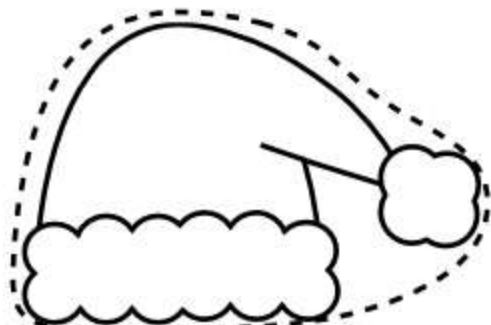
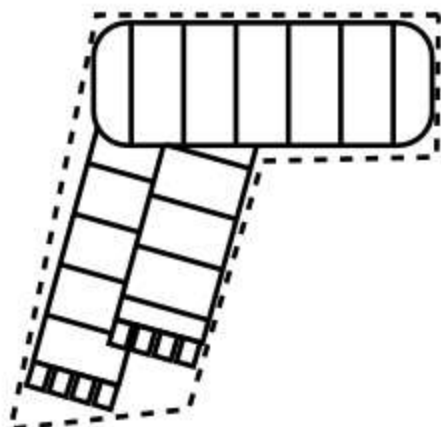
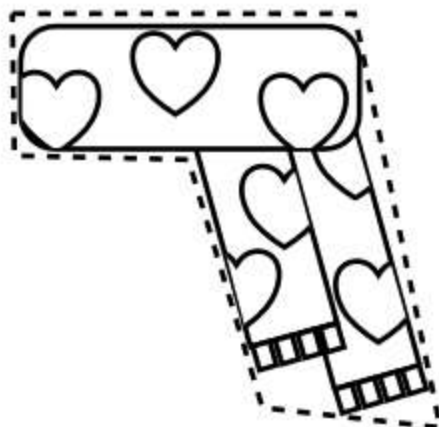
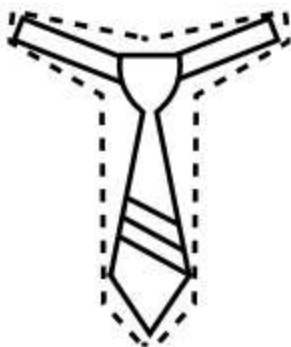


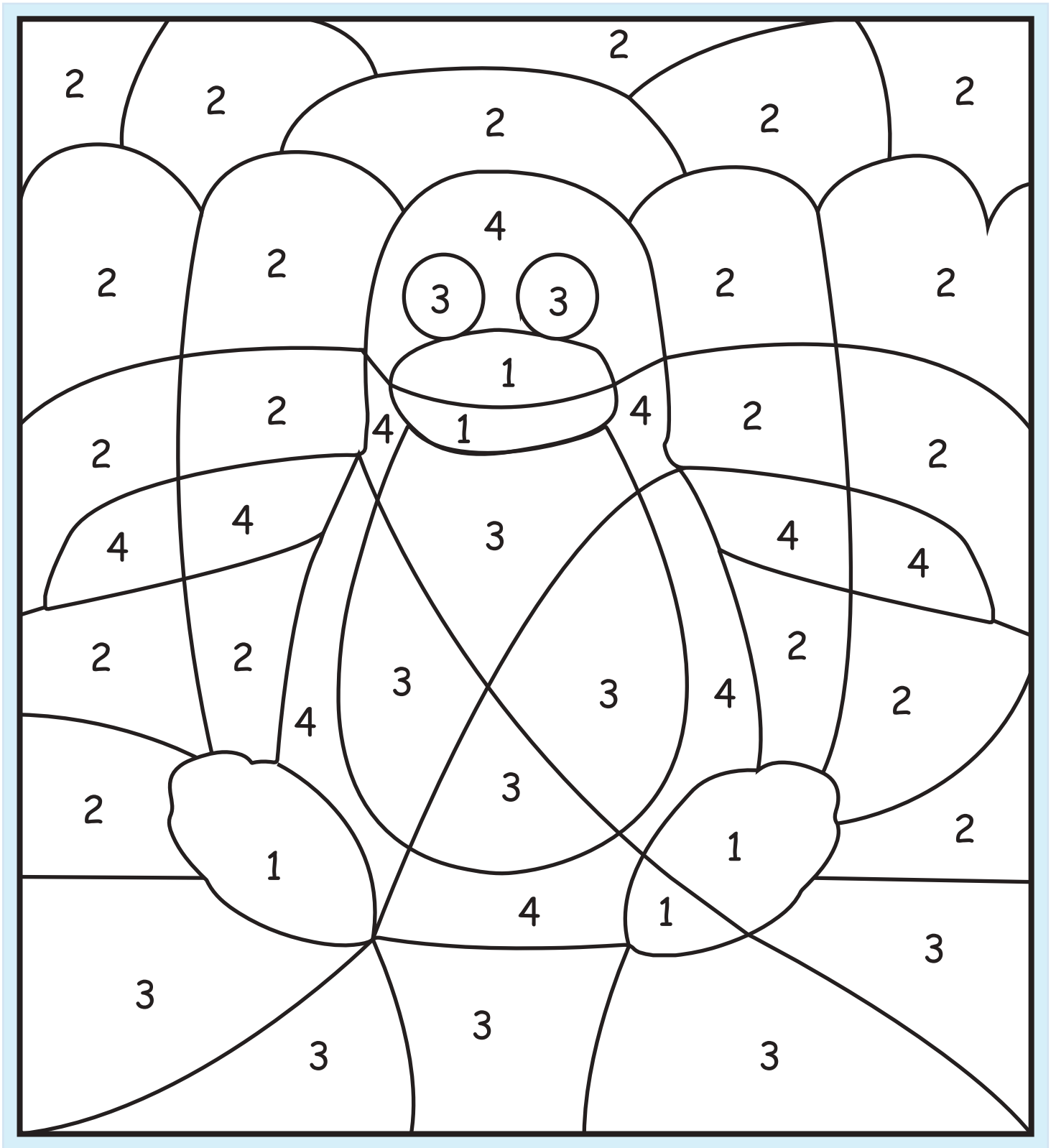
Build a Snowman!

Note: If you're snow man is really a snow woman, draw on some eye lashes :-)






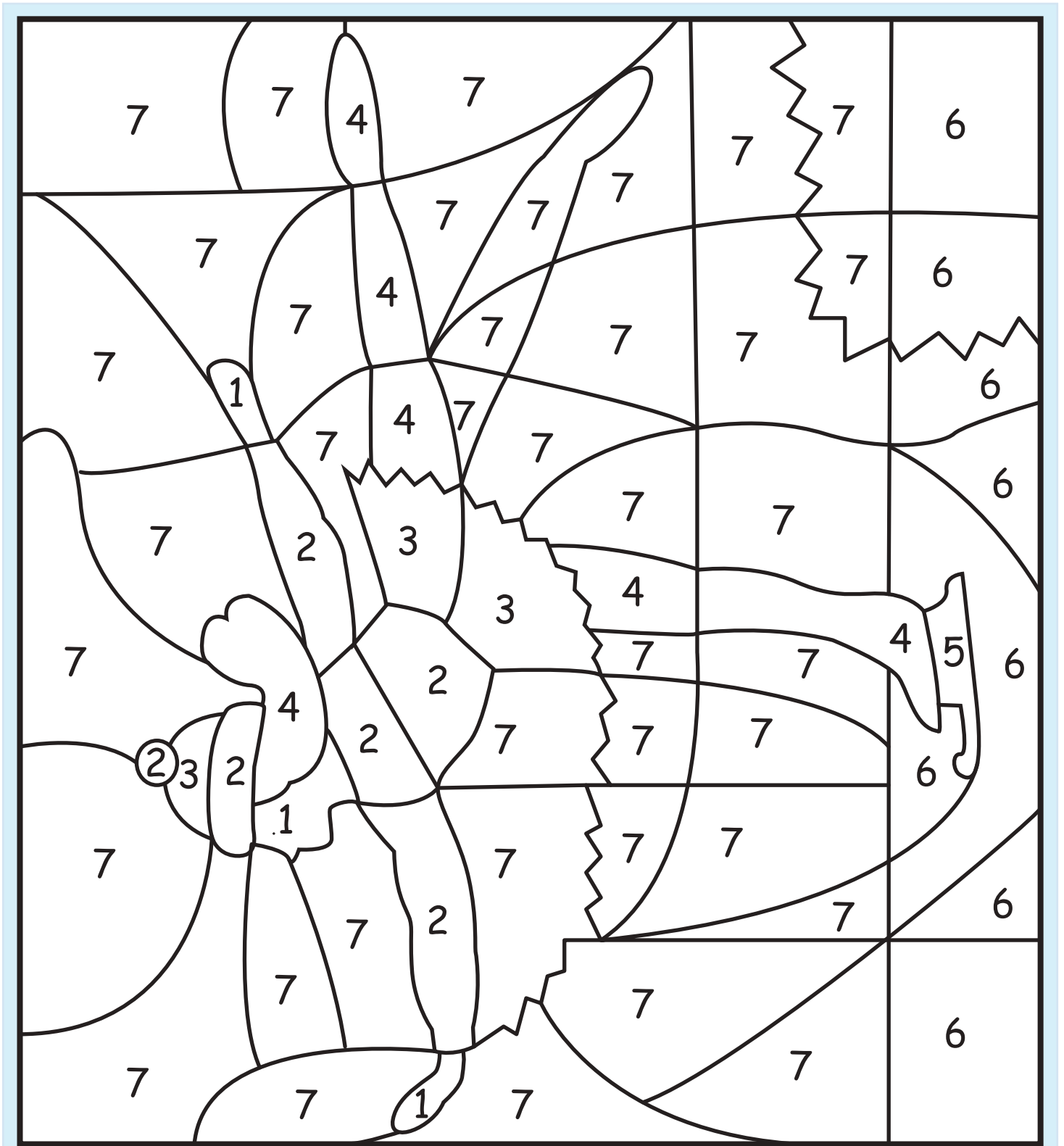
