## Corona Police Department Live-Scan Application Form

Each Owner, Officer, Manager and Employee identified on a Commercial Cannabis Permit Application must have their fingerprints rolled by a Live Scan service provider authorized by the California Department of Justice. The Live Scan service provider will submit the fingerprints and a City of Corona Police Department Live Scan form to the Department of justice

Owners, Officers, Mangers and Employees must use the attached pre-filled live can forms that contain City of Corona Police Department routing information. Please note that there are two different forms: one to be used by cannabis business employees; the other to be used by cannabis business owners.

- Employees of a prospective commercial cannabis business must submit a Live Scan form with "CANNABIS EMP 11105 B 11PC" printed in the "Application Type" box at the top right corner of the Live Scan form.
- Owners of a prospective commercial cannabis business must submit a Live Scan form with "CANNABIS LIC
  CA ONLY" printed in the "Applicant Type" box at the top right corner of the Live Scan form. An owner is
  defined by the State of California as any of the following:
  - (1) A person with an aggregate ownership interest of 20 percent or more in the person applying for a license or a licensee, unless the interest is solely a security, lien, or encumbrance.
  - (2) The chief executive officer of a nonprofit or other entity.
  - (3) A member of the board of directors of a nonprofit.
  - (4) An individual who will be participating in the direction, control, or management of the person applying for a license.
