(Enter off of Buena Vista Ave)**

**TIME:** **9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.**  
*Collection event may be closed during inclement weather.*



**Drop off any leftover hazardous materials from your home or garage.**  
**Household Hazardous Waste includes:**

Aerosol cans	Computers & monitors	Solvents
Ammonia	Fluorescent tubes	Syringes/needles
Antifreeze	Household batteries	TVs
Automotive batteries	Kerosene	Used oil and filters
BBQ propane tanks	Latex paints	<b>Medications &amp; Sharps</b>
Chlorine	Oil based paint	(Sharps must be in sealed Hard Plastic Containers, No Loose Sharps.)
Cleansers	Pesticides	

**Improper disposal of these materials can pollute the environment and threaten our public health.**

- Please limit to 15 gallons or 125 lbs. per vehicle. Multiple trips allowed.
  - Do not mix materials, keep original labels on containers.
  - Use a sturdy box in the trunk of your car. Gasoline containers will not be returned.
  - No explosives, ammunition or radioactive materials will be accepted.
  - No business or non-profit organization waste will be accepted.

## E-WASTE

E-waste is electronic equipment that usually has a circuit board, would include: TVs, Radios, computer monitors, printers, fax machines, scanners, cell phones, video game consoles, hair dryers, etc. Items that are not considered e-waste would include extension cords, toasters, blenders, or other small appliances.

## BULK PICK UP

The City of Corona offers residents a convenient way to dispose of large bulky household items via the Bulky Item Collection Program.

Each household may request up to three (3) **FREE** collections per year. **Please contact Waste Management Inc., at 800-423-9986 no later than 2 work days before your regularly scheduled trash and recycling collection day to schedule a pick up.**

Items may be placed out the evening before your scheduled collection day only

Acceptable Items	Unacceptable Items
Large Appliances (Refrigerators, Freezers, Air Conditioners)	No Tires, Automobile Parts
Water Heaters, Water Softeners	No Hazardous Waste, Chemicals, Toxic Material
Mattresses (must be wrapped in plastic), Sofas, Chairs, Tables	No Unframed or Bare Glass (must be framed)
Doors, Ladders, Glass Windows (framed), Sliding Doors	No Concrete or Asphalt
Exercise Equipment, Bicycles, Clothing	No Dead Animals
Patio Furniture, Barbeques, Lawn Mowers (remove tanks)	No Propane Tanks
Carpeting and Chain Link Fencing (must be rolled, 50 lb. maximum weight)	No Large Items in excess of 100 pounds
Any woody scraps, branches (Maximum length 4 feet, must be bundled and weight less than 50 pounds)
