

## NOTICE TO CORONA CITIZENS REGARDING PROPOSED ORDINANCE(S) No. 3347 & 3348

On May 18, 2022, the Corona City Council introduced the following Ordinance(s):

**Ordinance No. 3347** 

First reading of an ordinance and Police Department Policy Section 709 relating to the continued use and purchase of Military Equipment by the Police Department. On September 30, 2021, California Governor Gavin Newsom signed Assembly Bill 481 (AB481), which became effective January 1, 2022. The law requires the Police Department to create a Military Equipment Use Policy which must be approved and adopted by the City Council. The Police Department is seeking the adoption of the attached Ordinance, approval of Police Department Policy Section 709, and the continued use of specified military equipment by the Police Department and its mutual aid partners.

Ordinance No. 3348

First reading of an ordinance of an ordinance amending Chapter 2.09 of the Corona Municipal Code to modify the Code of Ethics and Conduct for Elected and Appointed Officials. Chapter 2.09 of the Corona Municipal Code provides a defined and actionable Code of Ethics that establishes guidelines for high ethical standards for elected and appointed officials. Ordinance No. 3348 proposes to amend the Code of Ethics to include a Code of Conduct, which provides more detailed guidelines on how city officials should conduct themselves in both public settings and private encounters.
