MEASURE TO BE VOTED ON

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following measure is to be voted on at the General Municipal Election to be held in the City of Corona, on Tuesday, the 8th of November, 2022.

"Shall the City of Corona adopt an ordinance enacting a gross receipts tax on commercial cannabis businesses of up to 9% for retail sale (including delivery), up to 7% for manufacturing and distribution, up to 3% for testing laboratories, and up to 15% for all other commercial cannabis businesses, generating approximately \$5,000,000 annually for general government use, such as police and emergency response, parks and youth/senior services, and street repair, until ended by voters?"
