About the NCS

- Report on the "liveability" of Corona; developed by the National Research Center at Polco
- Captures residents' opinions on 10 aspects of community:
 - 1. Economy
 - 2. Mobility
 - 3. Community Design
 - 4. Utilities
 - 5. Safety
 - 6. Natural Environment
 - 7. Parks and Recreation
 - 8. Health & Wellness
 - 9. Education, Arts, and Culture
 - 10. Inclusivity and Engagement
- Survey available in both English and Spanish
- Results benchmarked against 600 communities nationwide



Survey Methods

Random Sample Survey*

- > 7,000 households received survey mailings beginning May 16, 2022
- > 714 residents completed the random sample survey
 - o 10% response rate
 - o 4% margin of error

Open Participation Survey


- > Online survey open to all City residents beginning June 20, 2022
- Publicized on City website, email, and social media
- 310 residents completed the open participation survey





Overall Economic Health of Corona























- Park land acquisitions; parks revitalizations, redeveloping City Park.

Safety

- Upgrade and maintain 911 system to ensure reliable emergency response
- Determine appropriate staff levels for effective emergency response capability and address understaffing
- Improve emergency response times to meet or beat national benchmarks
- Expand resident engagement and involvement in police and fire support efforts
- Create Police Officer Business Liaison program to engage local businesses, provide advice on crime prevention, and respond to concerns
- Increase crime prevention in the downtown business district, including exploring the deployment of additional police officers dedicated to this area
