This is a public notice that the City of Corona's Planning and Housing Commission will conduct a public hearing in the City Council Chambers at 400 S. Vicentia Ave., on Monday, December 12, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. or thereafter upon the following:

CUP2021-0002: Conditional Use Permit application to establish a wireless telecommunications facility designed as a 60-foot faux eucalyptus tree within the Riverside County Oak Street Basin, located at the northeast corner of Chase Drive and Mangular Avenue in the Flood Plan (FP1) zone.

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) – Per Section 15070 of the State Guidelines for Implementation the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and Section 6.01 of the City's Local Guidelines, a negative declaration has been prepared for the project because the initial study showed that there is no substantial evidence in light of the whole record before the City that the project may have a significant effect on the environment.
