

GENERAL POLICIES

- 1. Corona residents are those individuals who reside within the City limits. 5. A \$45 service charge will be issued on all returned checks. Proof of residency include a photo ID and current utility bill which must match adult addresses and all registration forms.
- 2. Non-residents are classified as those addresses which do not lie within Corona city limits including, but not limited to, unincorporated areas such as Coronita, Home Gardens, El Cerrito, Corona Valley (Eastvale), and all communities south of Cajalco. The fees for non-residents are listed next to the activity.
- 3. All Classes must have a minimum enrollment before they will be offered. In case of lack of registrants, some classes may be combined or canceled. CLASS CANCELLATION POLICY Classes that do not meet the minimum participation requirement before the class start date will be canceled. If CLASSES ARE CANCELED, you will be notified and a credit or refund will be issued for the full amount of the course.
- 4. PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED for all classes and programs. TRANSFERS may be granted if the Community Services Department is notified PRIOR to the second scheduled class and after a 30-day check verification period.

REFUND & TRANSFER POLICY

- Class refunds and transfers may be granted if requested prior to the second scheduled class and after a 30-day check verification period.
- For all patron requested refunds or cancellations, there is a \$10 processing fee per activity, per participant.
- 6. REFUNDS: For all patron requested refunds or cancellations, there is a \$10 processing fee per activity, per participant. A refund will be granted after a 30-day check verification period.
 - Classes, Sports, & Aquatics Refunds will be granted if the Community Services Department is notified PRIOR to the second scheduled class.
 - Day Camps Refunds will be granted if the Community Services Department is notified the THURSDAY prior to the scheduled start date.
 - Kids Club After School Program Refunds will be granted if the Community Services Department is notified by noon on Monday of the week a participant is registered to attend.
 - 1-Day Workshops/Activities Refunds will be granted if the Community Services Department is notified the business day PRIOR to the scheduled start date.





Welcome

Thank you for your interest in the Ambassador volunteer Park opportunity. This program is an opportunity for residents to give back to the community while visiting their favorite parks. You can play a vital role in helping the Community Services Department keep Corona's parks beautiful. and functioning safe. for all residents.

Our volunteers serve as an extra set of eyes and ears to observe and report the overall condition of the parks they regularly visit. We sincerely appreciate your effort sand hope that you enjoy making a meaningful impact on Corona's Park System.

The first step in becoming a Park Ambassador is attending the monthly volunteer orientation for the Department of Community Services. Orientations are held on the third Monday of the month at 6:30 p.m. in the Corona Public Library's community rooms and will require an interview with the parks division staff.

Volunteer Duties

Volunteers are asked to act professionally while performing their duties and to interact respectfully with park patrons while representing the Community Services Department.

Volunteers should not take it upon themselves to correct any maintenance issues in the park. Park Ambassadors are expected to look over the features of the park and report their observations. They should report anything that appears to be a safety issue to their volunteer lead and the department.

Observation of any non-urgent maintenance issues will be reported by using the City's See, Click, Fix mobile application or by calling the Community Services Department.

Note:

Volunteers should NEVER confront park patrons or place themselves in harm's way. The first contact for emergencies is to call 911. Suspicious or illegal behavior should be reported to the Corona Police's non-emergency line, 951-736-2330, option 3.

Park Ambassadors are asked to do the following:

- Visit your assigned park once a week or twice a month at minimum
- Look over the features of the park and use the park observation checklist
- Utilize the See, Click, Fix app to report issues in the park that need to be fixed
- Make an effort to be informative and answer park patron questions
- Attend scheduled meetings with the Parks division of the department to goover progress and areas of concern
- Never confront or pursue persons involved in behavior that is illegal or suspicious



The City of Corona has a local notification system that sends telephone notifications to residents and businesses within Corona. Because the system uses the 9-1-1 database provided by the local telephone company, only land-line

CORONA MILITARY BANNER PROGRAM



The City's Military Banner program honors Corona residents and their immediate family members (spouse, child, parent, legal guardian, or sibling) who are serving on active duty in the United States Armed Forces. For the purpose of this program,

active duty is defined as 12 months of continuous service. To participate in the program, download and complete the application from the City's website at www.CoronaCA.gov. Please be sure to include proof of residency such as a current utility bill or driver's license listing a Corona address. Banners can be designed with the serviceperson's picture or without it. They are installed twice a year in May and November along Main, Magnolia, McKinley, Ontario, and Sixth Streets.

SAVER WATER & MONEY



The City of Corona Utilities Department offers its residents and businesses rebates on water-saving devices including toilets, clothes washers, rain barrels, rotating nozzles, and weatherbased irrigation timers. Business rebates

include toilets, urinals, ice-making machines, food steamers, dry vacuum pump, laminar flow restrictors, cooling tower conductivity controller, cooling tower pH controller, weatherbased irrigation controllers, rotating nozzles, and large rotary nozzles. GARAGE & YARD SALE REQUIREMENTS



Did you know a permit is required for a garage or yard sale in Corona? The City allows only three (3) sales per year per applicant or location. Display of sale items should not block the sidewalk, parkway, or any area within

the public right-of-way, as this could be a health and safety hazard. No more than two signs are allowed on the sale premises and no more than two additional signs off-premises. Be sure to get permission from the property owners where signs are placed. Do not place signs on utility poles, light poles, utility boxes, stop signs, or mailboxes, and don't forget to remove your signs after. Failure to do so may result in a citation.

When applying for a permit, be sure to list the personal items that you will be selling and post your permit on the premises while in progress. You can purchase a sales permit by visiting City Hall (400 S. Vicentia Avenue) or online by visiting www.CoronaCA.gov/Permits. To report an illegal garage sale after hours or on weekends or holidays, please contact the Police Department at (951) 736-2330. Good luck with your sale!
