

PUBLIC NOTICE

This is a public notice that the City of Corona's Planning and Housing Commission will conduct a public hearing in the City Council Chambers at 400 S. Vicentia Ave., on Monday, February 6, 2023, at 6:00 p.m. or thereafter upon the following:

CUP2021-0004: A Conditional Use Permit application to allow a drive-through and walk-up window coffee shop (Starbucks) within an existing commercial center located at the southeast corner of Green River Road and Dominguez Ranch Road in the Neighborhood Commercial District of the Sierra Del Oro Specific Plan.

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) – Per Section 15303(c) of the State Guidelines for the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and Section 3.27 of the City's Local CEQA Guidelines, a Notice of Exemption has been prepared for the project because the project qualifies as a Class 3 categorical exemption (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures), as the project consists of a new 966-square-foot coffee shop with drive-through and walk-up services only (no indoor seating), within an existing commercial center.
