STUDENTS:

- Posters should reflect the age and grade of the student and have a short message about wise and efficient water use inside & outside of the home, at school, in the community, in business, in agriculture, or in recreation.
- For example:
 - Collecting rainwater in buckets to water plants
 - Stop water run-off
 - Turn the water off while brushing your teeth
- Posters must be drawn horizontally within the border of the official poster paper: 
- Any writing or artwork in the 1-inch border area disqualifies the poster. 
- Use **BOLD, BRIGHT, BRILLIANT** colors - they show up best!
- Media can contain computer generated digital art, paint, crayons, pencils, markers, chalk, ink, fabric, pencil, cut paper, or watercolors.
- Artwork becomes the property of Utilities and may or may not be returned.
- Posters must use the original artwork only.
- NO computer, trademark or copyrighted artwork will be accepted.
- Please fill out form completely on back of poster paper.

NOTE: Please make sure all students complete all of the requested contact information on the back of their poster paper. This includes the students contact information, their parents contact information and signature on the permission slip, and the teachers contact information. POSTERS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IF THIS INFORMATION IS NOT COMPLETE!
