Solicitors are regulated by Chapter 5.34 of the Corona Municipal Code. Before an individual engages in soliciting activity pursuant to CMC Chapter 5.34, a permit shall be first issued by the city.

“Solicit”, “soliciting” or “solicitation” shall mean and include any request, offer, enticement, or action, by any person who is traveling by foot, vehicle or other type of conveyance from place to place or from door to door or at any temporary, and stationary location on public property, which announces the availability of services or for employment, the sale or exchange of goods or merchandise of any kind, or a request for funds or other property. As defined herein, a solicitation shall be deemed complete when made whether or not services are provided, an actual employment relationship is created, a sales or exchange transaction is completed or an exchange of money or other property takes place. The term solicit, soliciting or solicitation shall not include “sidewalk vendor activities” as defined in §5.35.020.

I understand the requirements for a solicitor permit according to Corona Municipal Code Chapter 5.34 and have read and agreed to abide by the requirements including the following:

_____ I acknowledge that this solicitor permit is valid for one year from the date of issuance.

_____ I acknowledge that this solicitor permit is personal and is not assignable or transferable, and is to only be used by the person to whom the solicitor permit is issued. Any change in ownership or operation of a solicitor permit requires a new solicitor permit.

_____ I acknowledge that it is unlawful to ring the bell of, knock on the door of, attempt to gain admittance or otherwise call attention to his or her presence of or at any residence, dwelling, flat or apartment whereon a sign bearing the words "No Solicitors", "No Soliciting" or "No Trespassing" is painted, affixed or exposed to public view.

_____ I acknowledge that soliciting by traveling from place to place or from street to street is prohibited between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m.

_____ I acknowledge that soliciting by driving, operating, or parking any automotive vehicle with a sound-making device, sound-amplifying device, or loudspeaker thereof in use, or operation or by making any outcry, blowing a horn, ringing a bell or using any sound device or musical instrument upon any of the streets, alleys, parks or other public places of the city is prohibited if any of the following occur:

- 1) When passing a hospital at any time or a church while services are being held therein;
- 2) Within 500 feet of the nearest property line of any property on which a school building is located during the hours school is in session;
- 3) Between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m.; and
- 4) Any such sound would exceed 65 decibels as measured ten (10) feet from the speaker or the sound-making or sound-amplifying device.

_____ I acknowledge that it is prohibited to sell or offer for sale, any goods, wares, merchandise, magazines, papers or periodicals, or canvas or solicit any other business or occupation at any special event, as defined in CMC Section 9.20.010, and if the special event is a parade, within 300 feet of any parade route on the day of the parade.

_____ I acknowledge that aggressive soliciting is prohibited in the following manner:

- 1) Coming closer than three (3) feet to the person solicited unless and until the person solicited indicates he or she wishes to make a purchase or otherwise receive the solicitation.
- 2) Blocking or impeding the passage of the person solicited.
- 3) Repeating the solicitation after the person solicited has indicated his or her objection to the solicitation.
- 4) Following the person solicited by proceeding behind, ahead or alongside such person after the person has indicated his or her objection to the solicitation.
- 5) Threatening the person solicited with physical harm by word or gesture or other means.
- 6) Abusing the person solicited with words which are offensive and inherently likely to provoke an immediate violent reaction.
- 7) Touching the solicited person without the solicited person's consent.

I have read and understand the provisions, rules and regulations of the City of Corona, California and the Municipal Code governing the solicitor permit for which I am applying. I declare, under penalty of perjury, that all of the information contained in this application and any accompanying documents is true and correct, with full knowledge that all statements made in this form are subject to investigation. Any false or dishonest answer to any question may be grounds for denial or subsequent revocation of permit.
