



# City of Corona Mayor's Youth Council

## **OBJECTIVES:**

- Provide young people with the opportunity to engage in civic issues.
- Encourage young people to participate in local government.
- Educate youth on issues facing the community.
- Obtain youth perspective on community issues.
- Provide leadership training and development to selected youth in the community.
- Create, identify, and/or enhance youth resources in Corona.
- Initiate educational campaigns notifying youth of resources and relevant issues.

## **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- o Represent the City of Corona to the best of your ability as a youth council member.
- o Provide input on issues affecting youth in the community.
- o Attend the regularly scheduled meetings of the youth council.

# CRITERIA:

- Must be a Corona resident.
- o Be enrolled in a Corona-Norco Unified School District high school or a private credential school (grades 9-12<sup>th</sup>) located within the City of Corona.
- Have at least a cumulative grade point average of 2.0.
- o Be able to attend meetings monthly during after school hours, city events, as well as City Council meeting once a quarter.
- Have the permission of parents or guardians to participate.
- Obtain the signature of a teacher or counselor as well as your school principal.
- Have an interest in leadership, civics, and community service.

# **APPLICATION PROCESS:**

- o Anyone interested in serving on the youth council shall fill out a youth council application, which requires signatures by a teacher or counselor as well as the school principal.
- o Applications are DUE to your principal by **Thursday**, **September 5**, **2024**. Applications received after the due date will not be accepted.
- Representatives will be selected from Centennial High School, Corona High School and Santiago High School, Orange Grove High School, Lee V. Pollard High School and other local private credential schools.
- o The principals will forward the applications to the City for final selection approval.
- o Schools and representatives will be notified by the City Youth Council staff by September 12th and installed at the October 2, 2024, City Council meeting.

## TERM OF OFFICE:

Each appointed youth council member shall serve until May 7, 2025.
