CORONA MILITARY BANNER PROGRAM



How do I participate in this program?



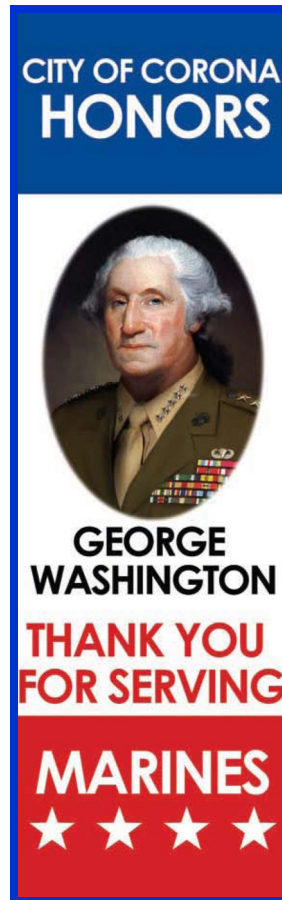
The Corona Military Banner program recognizes and honors Corona residents and immediate family members (spouse, parent, legal guardian, child, or siblings) that are serving on active duty in the United States Armed Forces. For the purpose of this program, “active duty” is defined as 12 months of continuous service. To participate in the program, fill out the attached application and include a copy of the driver’s license or a current utility bill showing the Corona address of the military serviceperson or his/her immediate family member. Quantity is limited to one (1) banner per serviceperson. Active duty status and program eligibility will be verified annually.

The spelling of the name will be taken directly from this application.

Once the application is approved, the City will create the banner. Banners will be installed twice a year (May and November) and will remain on display until the person is no longer serving on active duty, if the banner is damaged, or when the program concludes. Applicants residing outside of City limits are responsible for all cost associated with printing, installation and removal of banners.

Installation and removal of the banners are at the City’s discretion.

Sample Banners

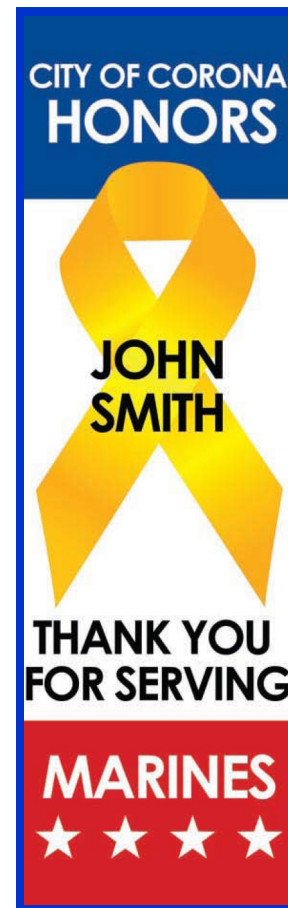


WAIVER:
