## **Hazardous Materials Screening Form**

A Hazardous Materials Business Plan is required to be submitted to the California Environmental Reporting System (CERS) at <a href="https://cers.calepa.ca.gov">https://cers.calepa.ca.gov</a> when any of the following are used, handled or stored:

- Hazardous Materials and/or waste in amounts equal to or greater than:
  - o 55 gallons of a liquid
  - o 500 pounds of a solid
  - o **200 cubic feet** of a compressed gas
  - o 200 cubic feet of liquefied Carbon Dioxide used for beverage carbonation
  - Any amount of Extremely Hazardous Substances (EHS) in amounts exceeding the threshold planning quantity as detailed in the CFR List of Lists <a href="https://www.epa.gov/epcra/consolidated-list-lists">https://www.epa.gov/epcra/consolidated-list-lists</a> or any amount of Acutely Hazardous Materials in amounts exceeding the threshold planning quantity as detailed in the California Code of Regulations List of Acutely Hazardous Chemicals, Toxics and Reactives found in <a href="https://www.dir.ca.gov/title8/5189a.html">https://www.dir.ca.gov/title8/5189a.html</a>
  - \*There are exemptions for some lubricating oils, medical and inert gases less than 1000 cubic feet, with approval.
  - \* Additional Fire Code permits may be required. Fire Code permits for hazardous materials are issued at no cost.
  - \* A Hazardous Materials permit will be issued by Riverside County Department of Environmental Health after payment is received and processed.
- A Hazardous Materials Business Plan is NOT required for the following:
  - Hazardous Substances contained in food, drug, cosmetic or tobacco products;
  - Hazardous materials contained solely in a consumer product for direct distribution to, and use by, the general public;
  - The transportation of hazardous materials accompanied by shipping papers in accordance with the provisions of Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations;
  - o Infectious Waste generated by Health Care Facilities regulated under Title 22 of the California Code of Regulations.

## **CHECK ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:**

No hazardous materials are handled, stored or used in this business.
Chemicals are used in this business, but do not meet the requirements for reporting as detailed above.
