



## PUBLIC NOTICE

This is a public notice that the City of Corona's Planning and Housing Commission will conduct public hearings in the Council Chambers, City Hall, 400 S. Vicentia Avenue, Corona, on Monday, October 23, 2017, at 6:00 p.m. or thereafter upon the following:

Application made by Vulcan Materials Company to amend an existing Surface Mining Permit 12-001 to expand the entitlements to construct and operate an elevated conveyor system arm across the Temescal Wash to the adjacent 10.72 acres that is used for stock pile/sales yard purposes and across Sherborn Street to the rail load out area and the construction of a 6,300 square foot modular office and warehouse located at 1545 Sherborn Street in the M-3 (Heavy Manufacturing/Mineral Resource Overlay) Zone. The City has prepared an Environmental Evaluation to analyze the potential environmental impacts of the project and whether the environmental impacts of the project were adequately addressed in the Corona Quarry Environmental Impact Report, previously certified on March 2, 1989. The evaluation indicated that the Project will not result in impacts beyond what was previously analyzed in the EIR and 2014 Addendum because the project does not have any new or substantially more severe environmental impacts. As permitted by the State of California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Sections 15162 (a), an addendum to the EIR was prepared to address only those issues specific to the amendment.
