

## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

This is a public notice that the City of Corona's Planning and Housing Commission will conduct public hearings in the Council Chambers, City Hall, 400 S. Vicentia Avenue, Corona, on Monday, November 6, 2017, at 6:00 p.m. or thereafter upon the following:

**CZ17-002**: An application requesting to change the zoning of 1.9 acres from R-1-7.2 (Single Family Residential, Minimum Lot Size 7,200 square feet) and 0.24 acres from R-2 (Low Density Multi-Family Residential) to R-3 (Multiple-Family Residential) located on the east side of Buena Vista Avenue approximately 480 feet north of Bollero Place and north of the State Route 91 overpass and consideration of a Mitigated Negative Declaration regarding potential environmental impacts associated with the proposed application.

**GPA17-001**: Application requesting to amend the General Plan Land Use Map designation of 2.14 acres from MDR (Medium Density Residential, 6-15 du/ac) to HDR (High Density Residential, 15-36 du/ac) located on the east side on Buena Vista Avenue approximately 480 feet north of Bollero Place and north of the State Route 91 overpass in the proposed R-3 (Multiple-Family Residential) Zone and consideration of a Mitigated Negative Declaration regarding potential environmental impacts associated with the proposed application.

**CUP17-004**: A conditional use permit application to establish a senior citizen housing consisting of 64 apartments on 2.14 acres located on the east side of Buena Vista Avenue approximately 480 feet north of Bollero Place and north of the State Route 91 overpass in the R-3 (Multiple-Family Residential) zone being proposed by CZ17-002 and consideration of a Mitigated Negative Declaration regarding potential environmental impacts associated with the proposed application.
